

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

**John H. Ammon Medical Education Center

From I-95 northbound:

Take Exit 3B onto Rt. 273 west. Turn right at Rt. 4 east. Follow Rt. 4 for one and one-quarter miles. Turn right onto Hygeia Drive to enter Christiana Hospital campus. Follow event parking signs.

From I-95 southbound:

Take Exit 4B onto Rt. 58 west. Follow Rt. 58 one mile. Turn left at the light to enter Christiana Hospital campus. Follow event parking signs.

From Rt. 1/Rt. 7 northbound:

Take Exit 166 onto Rt. 58 west. Follow Rt. 58 for six-tenths of a mile. Turn left at the light to enter Christiana Hospital campus. Follow event parking signs.

From Rt. 7 southbound:

Follow Rt. 7 to right turn onto Rt. 4 west. Turn left onto Rt. 58 east. Go three-tenths of a mile and turn right onto Christiana Hospital campus. Follow event parking signs.

From New Jersey:

After crossing the Delaware Memorial Bridge, follow I-295 to I-95 south Exit 4B to Rt. 58 west. Follow Rt. 58 one mile. Turn left at the light to enter Christiana Hospital campus. Follow event parking signs.

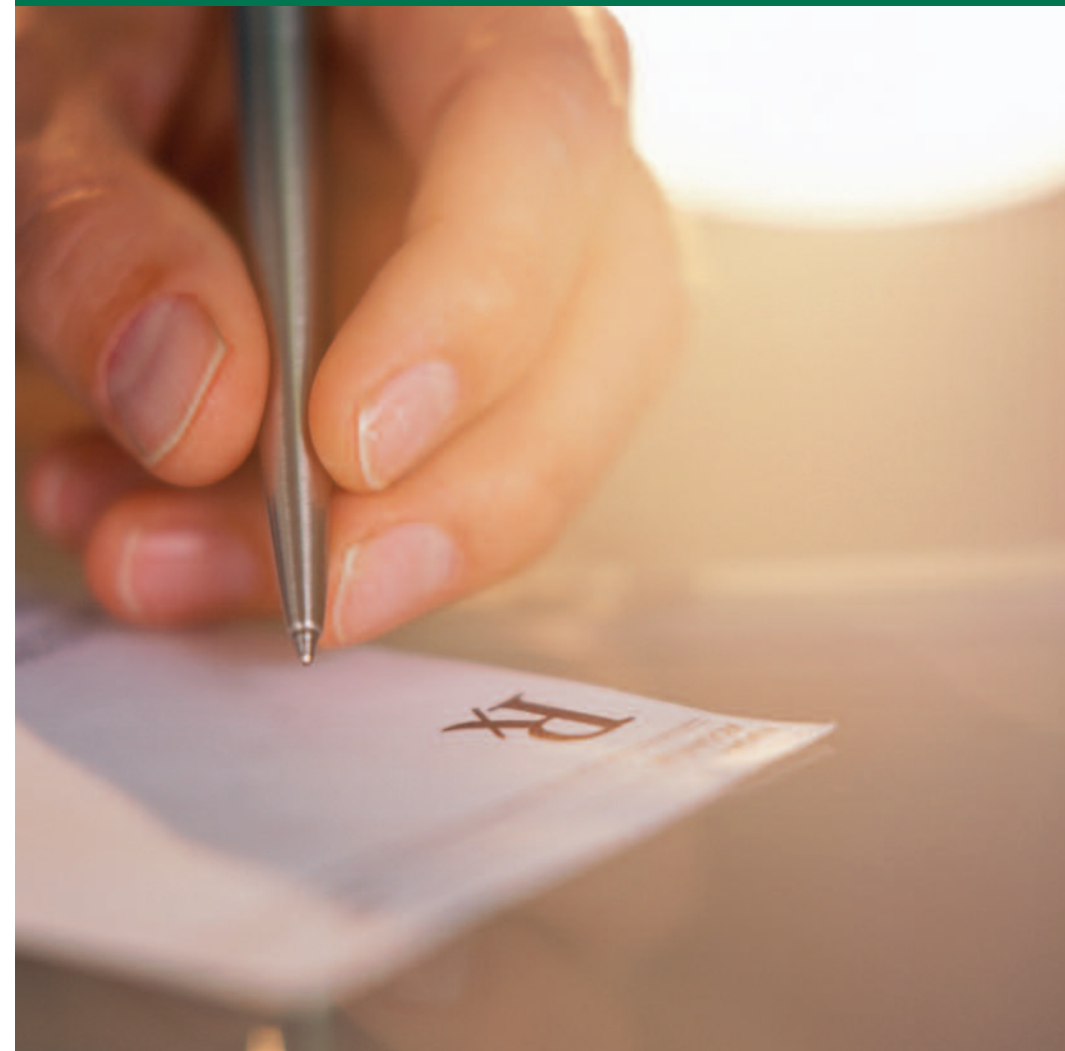
