## What is a Medical Assistant?

Guided by our values, a Medical Assistant or MA is a medical professional who is responsible for working alongside physicians and advanced practitioners in outpatient and ambulatory care facilities, such as medical offices and clinics.

### Some Examples of Duties

#### ADMINISTRATIVE

- Welcome Patients.
- Maintain Electronic Health Records.
- Schedule Appointments.
- Prior Authorizations, Referrals, Med Refills.

#### CLINICAL

- Take Medical Histories.
- Perform Quality Control Procedures.
- Prepare Patients for Examinations.
- Assist Clinicians with Procedures.
- Collect & Prepare Laboratory Specimens.
- Perform Basic Lab Tests.
- Sterilization & Disinfection Technique.
- Prepare & Administer Medications.
- Draw Blood & Take Electrocardiograms.

## Program Details

Earn a diploma with Delaware Technical Community College that transfers 36 credits towards an Associates Degree or Bachelors Degree.

Complete a hands-on clinical 160 hour externship with one of the practices within the ChristianaCare Medical Group.

Externship opportunities include Primary Care, Women's Health, Oncology, Urology, or other specialty care sites.

With completion of classroom coursework & an externship you will sit for the Certified Medical Assistant Exam with the AAMA or the Registered Medical Assistant Exam with AMT.

Medical Assistant University graduates are eligible to be hired directly into a ChristianaCare Medical Group MA position.

Attend classes with fellow MA University students to form social and networking bonds together.

MA University Students will be required to attend class/externship every day Monday- Friday. Eight hour days in a classroom setting or externship medical office.

Note: This is a time intensive program and individuals will not be able to successfully complete the program with absences deemed excessive based on the program curriculum.

## Program Expectations

- Successful completion\* of the program including:
- Successful completion of each course through Delaware Technical Community College with a passing score, C average or higher.
  - Passing Score on the CMA or RMA exam.
  - Medical Assistant University Students who successfully complete the program will be considered for a ChristianaCare Medical Group Medical Assistant position.
  - A one-year commitment to ChristianaCare is required after the six month program.

\*CCHS Positive Discipline Program will be initiated for any student who is not successful in completing the coursework or exam.

## Eligibility

- 1) Current Christiana Care employee in good standing, at least 1 year of service.
- 2) High School Graduate or equivalent.
- 3) Ability to use computer applications & systems.
